

4 次の英文は、ミサコ (Misako) が、青森県 (Aomori Prefecture) を訪れる外国人旅行者について英語の授業で行ったスピーチです。これを読んで、後の(1)~(3)に答えなさい。*の語句には、スピーチの後に(注)があります。(21 点)

The number of foreign people who visited Aomori Prefecture increased from 59,100 in 2010 to 239,150 in 2017. Miyagi Prefecture was No.1 in the *Tohoku area before. But in 2017, Aomori Prefecture became No.1 for the first time. Aomori is loved by *Asian people very much because there are many beautiful lakes and mountains in Aomori. So people from other countries want to visit such *tourist places and popular towns in Aomori.

Do you know that Asian countries buy a lot of apples from Aomori? Apples in Aomori are very popular in Asian countries. These days, many Asian people like *local experience-based activities when they visit Aomori. For example, they enjoy *picking and eating apples in the *orchards. Also, most of them have never seen snow. So Aomori Prefecture is trying to *advertise its beautiful *ski areas to Asian people.

By the way, there are some problems. In Aomori, most of the people can't speak English and there are not many *interpreters. It is difficult for foreign people to communicate with the people who live there in English. So Aomori Prefecture is trying increase its interpreters and foreign language *displays. I hope that many people from other countries will come to and enjoy Aomori Prefecture.

My mother loves one of the Japanese *figure skaters, so we decided to go there to watch his *performance. It was perfect and very beautiful. His performance attracted many people from different countries. Everyone *was impressed by his performance. He won a gold medal, so we were really excited."

Mr. Brown said to Hiroko, "Yes. I watched his performance on TV. It was excellent! Did you watch any other sports?" Hiroko answered, "We also watched *the curling games. The curling games were very interesting. In curling, the Japanese women's team got *a bronze medal. After the match, the Japanese team and *the opposing team *applauded each other. This touched our heart." Mr. Brown said, "You had very good experiences!"

"By the way, do you know when the first Olympics started?" Mr. Brown asked Hiroko. She answered, "I don't know." Mr. Brown said, "OK. The Summer Olympics were started in 1896 and the Winter Olympics in 1924. Now they are known as one of the largest sports festival in the world. The Winter and the Summer Olympics were held in the same year But the Winter Olympics have not been popular for a long time. So the Winter and the Summer Olympics were separated to show people the greatness of the Winter Olympics. The next Winter Olympics after 1992 were in 1994."

"Do you know how many countries joined the first Winter Olympic games?" asked Mr. Brown. "About one hundred?" said Hiroko. "No. Actually, only sixteen countries were in the first Winter Olympics. But in the Pyeongchang Olympics, there were ninety-two," said Mr. Brown. "Wow! That's amazing. The Winter Olympics are getting more popular," Hiroko said.

Mr. Brown said, "I hope many people watch the Olympics. I think the Olympics are very good chances to share joy with a lot of people around the world." Hiroko said to Mr. Brown, "I really agree with you. The Olympics are full of fun! I am more interested in the Tokyo Olympics in 2020."
